Welcome to Black Hills State University. We are located in Spearfish, which is in the northern portion of the beautiful Black Hills. Spearfish is only 17 miles from Sturgis and it's interstate all the way! Vroom, Vroom!!

Once again, BHSU will offer on-campus housing to the public during the Sturgis Rally. Should you decide to stay with us, you will be housed in a non-air-conditioned residence hall room. However, most common areas are air-conditioned and there is a fan in EVERY room! Room capacity is limited to 2 people. Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult aged 21 or older.

All rooms are furnished with two long-length twin beds, dressers, desks, chairs, and a sink. Room size is approximately 12'x14'.

Bedding and towels are included in the room price. This service has been added for your convenience. No more mailing linen ahead and no trying to find space on your cycle.

Community bathrooms (complete with toilet, sink, and shower area) are located on each floor. Bathrooms on each floor are designated by gender.


