### **Featured Rides of Northern AZ:**

The Mother Road...Route 66...  
310 Miles and 5 hours riding time  
Ride the Mother Road, Route 66, through Arizona...the longest single stretch of active Route 66 in the country.  
Make a stop in historic Seligman for lunch.

Jerome/Cottonwood/ Page Springs/  
Village of Oak Creek/ Sedona and  
Back through Camp Verde/ Mayer/  
Prescott Valley to Prescott.  
152 miles and 3.5 hours total riding time.  
This ride has a mix of scenic, open terrain,  
152 mountain curves, "city riding", and  
a short stretch on I-17.

Skull Valley/Kirkland Loop Ride  
A short ride with scenic open panoramas  
of the Arizona high desert as well pine  
covered mountain curves.

Bagdad, Arizona - the ride to/from  
Bagdad offers a fantastic ride through  
Arizona's high and low desert along curvy  
roads and a big sky.

The Grand Canyon...242 miles and 4  
hours riding time, not including time  
spent in the Grand Canyon National Park  
itself. A great place to stop on the way  
is Williams, AZ, founded in the late 1800's.
